Last Teaching: A Threat to CommUnity

Mark 9:33-34: They came to Capernaum. When he was in the house, he asked them, "What were you arguing about on the road?" But they kept quiet because on the way they had argued about who was the greatest.

Acts 7:9: Because the patriarchs were jealous of Joseph, they sold him as a slave into Egypt. But God was with him.

Mark 9:35: Sitting down, Jesus called the Twelve and said, "If anyone wants to be first, he must be the very last, and the servant of all."

This Week's Teaching

1. Battles Within

James 4:1: What causes fights and quarrels among you? Don't they come from your desires that battle within you?

2. Wrong Approach

James 4:2: You want something but don't get it. You kill and covet, but you cannot have what you want. You quarrel and fight. You do not have, because you do not ask God.

3. Right Motives?

James 4:3: When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.

4. Love of the World

James 4:4-5: You adulterous people, don't you know that friendship with the world is hatred toward God? Anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God. Or do you think Scripture says without reason that the spirit he caused to live in us envies intensely?

5. Grace to the Humble

James 4:6, 10: But he gives us more grace. That is why Scripture says: "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."... Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up.

COMMUNITY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Based on last week's teaching:

1. Is there anyone of whom you are jealous now? What causes the jealousy?
2. What do you need to do to overcome pockets of jealousy in your life? For example, do you need to forgive a person of whom you are jealous?

Based on this week's teaching:

3. What are generally the strongest sinful desires for men--and for women?
4. What sinful desires battle within your heart and mind?
5. How do sinful desires sometimes cause you to act in ungodly ways?
6. Do you depend upon God for your needs?
7. Do you have selfish motives in asking God to provide things for you? How so?
8. How is it that God loves the world (John 3:16), but we are not to do so (1 John 2:15)?
9. What does it mean that God gives grace to the humble (James 4:6)?
10. How has God shown you grace?
